The Bhima Devi Temple Complex, also known as Khajuraho of North India for its erotic sculptures, comprises the restored ruins of an ancient Hindu temple dated between 9th and 11th century AD, together with the adjacent 17th century Pinjore located in Panchkula. Scientific clearance on site revealed a Panchayatana style of temple architecture.

Temple was decorated with variety of sculptures as visible from the remnants, which depicts Shiva & Parvati, Agni, Surya, Vishnu, Ganesha, Chaitya windows, Miniature turrets, and other social, animal and plant motifs.
