The Jahaj Kothi or the house in the form of a ship stands on the east of the town. George Thomas, a native of Ireland and the uncrowned ruler of the territory between Sirsa and Rohtak built this building for his residence in 1766. Owing to its isolated location, it gives an impression of a ship in the ocean (surrounded by a huge open area) and that is what justifies the name 'Jahaj Kothi'. The museum housed in this structure has gallery as well as showcase display in the permissible movement area within the structure. The collection comprises of archaeological material from various Harappan sites, sculptures of various sites, historical sites artefacts and images of various excavation material and monuments of Haryana.
